Our Challenge by Choice and Expeditionary Learning programs are central to this experience. These are not optional extras, but integral components of the Living Academy journey.

Every student is required to participate fully, and this commitment pays off: by engaging in these real-world challenges, students develop skills that extend far beyond the classroom—building character, resilience, and a deep sense of personal responsibility.

Our Expeditionary Learning is designed around a two-year programme with intentional fieldwork to complement our school-based teaching. We intentionally engineer programs for students to be away from home, to learn the art of travel, to experience camping in nature, to disconnect from digital addictions.

Term 1 - English


Term 2 - Maths and Science


IB DIPLOMA PROGRAM: Pathways to University and Global Success

As students enter Year 11 and Year 12, Living Academy offers a prestigious and comprehensive pathway through the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). This world-class qualification is recognized by leading universities in Australia and across the globe, preparing students for tertiary education with a strong academic foundation and the personal attributes required to thrive.

Students have two options:

- **Full IB Diploma**: A rigorous, two-year programme that challenges students across six subject areas, develops critical thinking, and fosters international-mindedness. This pathway is ideal for students aiming for top-tier universities, providing a well-rounded education that is highly regarded worldwide.
- **IB Courses**: For students seeking flexibility, individual courses can be taken as part of their final years, offering a tailored academic experience while still building toward university pathways. Students choosing IB Courses must take an English course; all other subject selections are limited only by availability and timetable restrictions. Students can combine this pathway with UniStart in Year 12 to guarantee direct entry to Southern Cross University.

A third pathway to explore is a personal trade focus. Where we guide students to find trade-based interests and explore the qualifications needed to be certified and work-ready.



The IB Diploma Programme we offer extends into six subject groups with multiple courses on offer.

To gain a full diploma students must meet the guidelines set by the International Baccalaureate, which includes studying a language from start so there is no complication if you have not studied a language previously.

At the heart of the IBDP are the core areas that explore the process and purpose of learning beyond a subject's specific content. The Theory of Knowledge (TOK), the research focus on a student's area of interest (Extended Essay), and the CAS - Creativity, Activity and Service.
